LENTEN OBSERVANCES

Abstinence

Everyone fourteen years of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

Fast

Everyone eighteen years of age and older, but under the age of sixty is also bound on Good Friday. On this day the law allows only one full meal, but does not prohibit taking some food during the day, so long as this does not constitute another full meal. Drinking liquids during the day is permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. In the spirit of penance, the faithful should not lightly excuse themselves from this obligation.

LENTEN ACTIVITIES

Benediction and Evening Prayer

We will have Benediction and Evening Prayer on Palm Sunday, March 16th at 4:00 p.m. in the church.

Stations of the Cross

There will be Stations of the Cross every Friday morning during Lent at 9:00 a.m. in the church.

Holy Hour

There will be an hour of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament every Tuesday morning after the 8:30 a.m. Mass

ADULT EDUCATION
