**GRIEF SUPPORT GROUP**

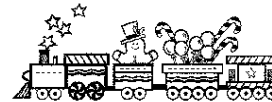
In this season of remembrance and gratitude, there's a

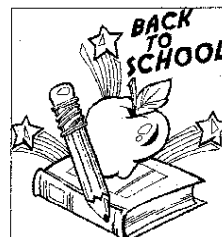
