LENTEN OBSERVANCES

Abstinence

Everyone fourteen years of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on **Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.**

Fast

Everyone eighteen years of age and older, but under the age of sixty is also bound on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. On these two days, the law of fast allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food during the day, so long as this does not constitute another full meal. Drinking liquids during the day is permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. In doubt concerning fast or abstinence, a priest assigned to pastoral ministry or confessor should be consulted. In the spirit of penance, the faithful should not lightly excuse themselves from this obligation.

Benediction and Evening Prayer

We will have Benediction and Evening Prayer on March 8th, the Second Sunday of Lent and on Palm Sunday, April 5th at 4:00 p.m. in the church.

Stations of the Cross
